INTERNATIONAL MEETING AMONG RESEARCHERS, ENTERPRISES AND INVESTORS FOR FINAL SELECTION OF BEST <NO-BLE IDEAS>

As a partner in NO-BLE Ideas project and leader of work package 6 “Pilot projects for the development of young innovators ideas at the entrepreneurial level” the Chamber of Commerce and Industry Vratsa invites you to be our guest at the International meeting among researchers, enterprises and investors for final selection of best <NO-BLE ideas> in the Agro-Food Sector.

The International Meeting will take place on 25th and 26th of March, 2014 in Vratsa, Bulgaria, “Hristo Botev” square, House of Culture, 2nd floor. CCI-Vratsa organizes the meeting as a round-table where 14 applications by researchers and innovators from all partner countries will be presented and discussed. At the end of the meeting 7 ideas will be finally selected for funding.

The shortlist of 14 applicable ideas is prepared by CCI-Vratsa in cooperation with the scientific partners MTA ATK, Hungary and INCDBA-IBA, Romania.

During the implementation period of activity 6.1 ‘Transnational competition competition for best <NO-BLE> Ideas’ the selection of best NO-BLE Ideas was prepared. The Shortlist of the selected 14 NO-BLE Ideas is published by the end of January, 2014.

Two ideas/two ideators per each Local Point - CCI/AA (Bari, Italy); CCI-Vratsa (Vratsa, Bulgaria); STP (Maribor, Slovenia); Ministry of Agriculture (Tirana, Albania); Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia (Belgrade, Serbia); KM-RIU (Gödöllő, Hungary); CCIAT Timisoara (Romania) are selected to participate in the International Meeting in Vratsa, Bulgaria.

The international Meeting will be attended by the shortlisted researchers, enterprises, investors and guests of SEE area and will have four main sessions: 1) short session for project presentations, 2) debate session for questions from entrepreneurs and investors, 3) closed session only for investors and entrepreneurs, 4) final session with the announcement of best 7 NO-BLE Ideas. All partners will attend the meeting.
